NITE MOVES ALL-COMER

COLLIN WOLF WINS 10 & UNDER LONG JUMP

The Striders opened the 2018 indoor season at the Nite Moves All-Comers meet held at the U.S. Air Force Academy on Sunday, January 7th.

Collin Wolf led the Striders by winning the 10 and under boy's long jump with a new club record effort of 10'9 1/2". Brandon Hills added an additional club record in the 13-14 boy's long jump with a 3rd place jump of 16'1 3/4". He later set a new club record in the 60 meters with a time of 8.25.
